He has danced with Karmen Larumbe and Marck Tompkins and created his own school and company in 1994. His teaching is precise and vibrant enriched with the wide spectrum of techniques (Classic, Contemporary, Eurythmy, Modern, Indian, African, Jazz and Theater) from his travels and trainings.



Jaimen McMillan developed the discipline of Spacial Dynamics® in 1985. It is an internationally recognized and growing body of spatially oriented movement exercises, activities, and games, a unique spatial approach to posture, and a refined method of movement observation and analysis. Jaimen gives lectures and workshops worldwide, and regular trainings in the US, England, Germany, and Hungary. He has written articles for educational and health journals and is a contributing author for books dealing with pedagogy and therapy.

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
