Level III Certification in Spacial Dynamics®

Goals

The long term objective is to carry the educational, therapeutic, and social impulses of Spacial Dynamics® into the future. The goal of Level III Certification Program is to teach SDI graduates to carry out, in conjunction with the Spacial Dynamics Institute, training programs in various locations and countries. Level III graduates will be certified as Level I Instructors and Mentors. It will take a team of three Level III instructors to conduct Level I Trainings.

The Level III course will:

- Augment personal movement and therapeutic skills, and enhance the ability to teach these in Level I Trainings.
- Provide an in-depth understanding and ability to present Spacial Dynamics® and Bothmer Gymnastics®, both in theory and movement, to SDI students.
- Teach group building techniques and how to address possible challenges within the multi-year training models.
- Introduce techniques to address the changing needs of individuals within an SDI group.
- Teach the SDI embraced Code of Ethics and Professional Standards of ISMETA.
- Build an international network of Level III Trainers who will carry and develop the discipline of Spacial Dynamics®.

Admission Criteria

- Spacial Dynamics® Level I and Level II Diplomas
- Bothmer Gymnastics® Certification
- Strength in several movement areas
- Capacity to maintain individual practice and be a vital part of a team
- Willingness and ability to change
- Quality of work done with Spacial Dynamics in the past years
- Application and Acceptance by the Level III Admissions Committee

Program Description

The Level III Certification Program will take place over a three-year period. Six Level III sessions (two per year) must be completed successfully to receive certification, in addition to the mentoring and personal study. The annual tuition covers the mentoring and the two sessions.

A total of three sessions will be offered each year to provide scheduling flexibility and students are invited and encouraged to attend the additional session if they are able to, at no extra charge.

The Level III Certification Program will consist of:

- Advanced, intense, and personalized movement training
- Advanced studies in Pedagogy, Presentation, and Presence
- Study of the Five-Year Level I Spacial Dynamics Curriculum
- Personal and group work in Spacial Dynamics® and Bothmer Gymnastics®
- Personalized development programs
- Regular working on a team master's research project.
- Participation in on-going Level I training groups as possible

Program Calendar

Year One : January 2 -6, 2011, April 26-30, 2011, August 15-19, 2011

The courses begin at 7:30 pm on the first evening and conclude at 12:00 pm on the last day.

Tuition for the Level III Certification Program is \$6,600 per year.
